Principal welcomed the gathering and the minutes of the previous meeting was read by the IQAC coordinator and approved.

Agenda points were discussed and resolutions were made.

1. Review of Academic Calendar Implementation

Discussion:

The Coordinator presented a detailed review of the ongoing academic calendar for the current academic year. It was observed that the majority of teaching schedules, internal assessments, and co-curricular activities are being conducted as planned. Some departments requested minor adjustments due to unexpected holidays and examination rescheduling.

Resolution:

- Departments must strictly adhere to the revised academic calendar.
- Any future changes should be communicated to IQAC at least one week in advance.
- The IQAC will monitor monthly progress to ensure timely completion of syllabi.

Agenda 2: Monitoring and Tutoring System Updates

Discussion

- The functioning of the Mentor–Mentee tutoring system was reviewed.
- Mentors reported student needs related to academics, attendance, counseling, and career guidance.
- The need for maintaining updated mentor records such as mentoring sheets, action plans, and progress reports was emphasized.
- Special attention was discussed for slow learners and students with low attendance.

Resolution 2

It was **resolved** that:

- Each mentor shall conduct two mentoring sessions per month and maintain proper documentation.
- Departments must identify slow learners and implement remedial classes.
- Advanced learners should be given special training for competitive exams, presentations, and project work.
- A consolidated mentoring report must be submitted to IQAC at the end of every month.

Agenda 3: Strengthening of Interdisciplinary Teaching Initiatives

Discussion

- The committee discussed methods to promote interdisciplinary learning between departments.
- Suggestions included joint lectures, collaborative projects, skill-based certificate courses, and interdisciplinary electives.
- Faculty expressed interest in co-teaching sessions to share expertise across disciplines.
- The IQAC proposed developing short-term interdisciplinary modules relevant to industry needs.

Resolution 3

It was **resolved** that:

- Departments will plan at least one interdisciplinary teaching activity per semester.
- Joint lectures, seminars, and guest sessions involving two or more departments will be organized.
- Proposals for interdisciplinary certificate courses will be prepared and submitted to the College Council.
- IQAC will monitor the outcomes of interdisciplinary activities for NAAC documentation.

Agenda 4: Activities of NSS / YRC / Clubs

Discussion

- NSS, YRC, and various student clubs presented their activity reports for the semester.
- Proposed activities included health camps, blood donation drives, disaster management awareness, campus cleaning, literacy campaigns, and environmental initiatives.

• The need for proper planning and documentation of each activity was highlighted for NAAC and institutional records.

Resolution 4

It was **resolved** that:

- NSS, YRC, and Clubs must conduct minimum two activities per semester focusing on social responsibility, health, environment, and community engagement.
- Departments are encouraged to collaborate with NSS/YRC for extension activities.
- Photo documentation, attendance, reports, and media coverage must be submitted to IQAC within three days of the event.
- A Community Engagement Calendar will be drafted and approved by IQAC.

The Chairperson appreciated the active participation of members and emphasized the importance of continuous quality enhancement. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by the IQAC Coordinator.
